Providing adults with developmental disabilities support and opportunities to improve employability, independence, and self-confidence.

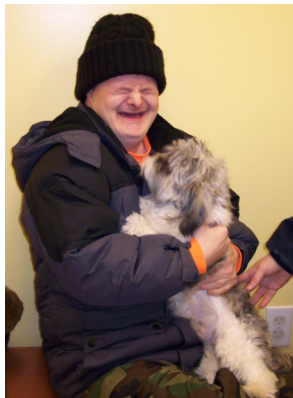
