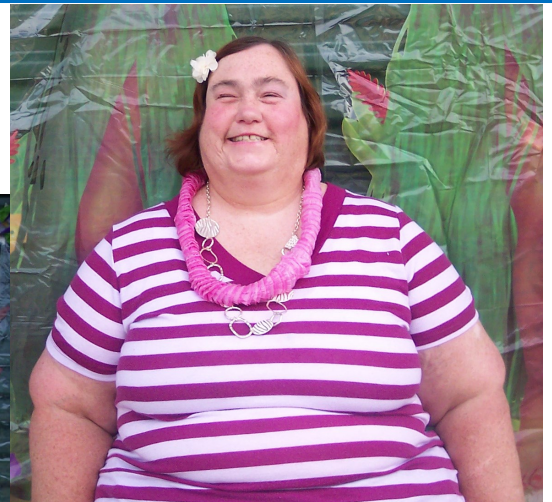
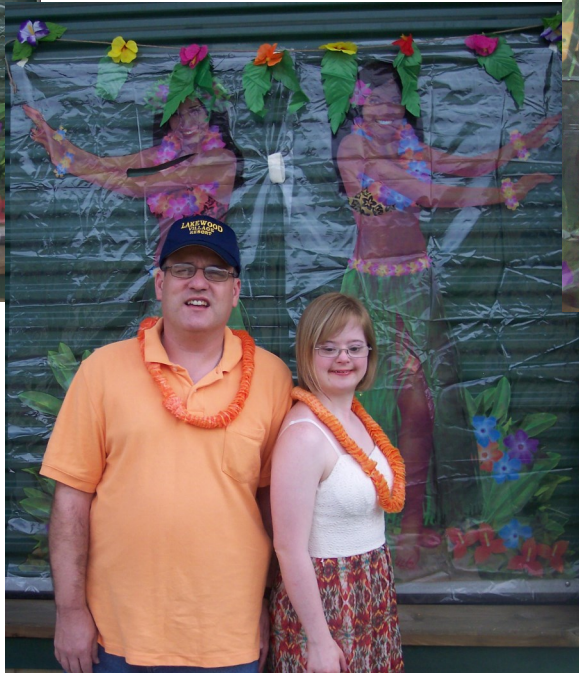
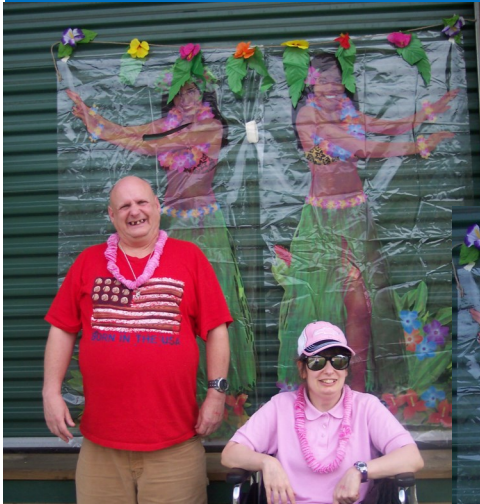

Other creative individualized employment opportunities are also available for participants.



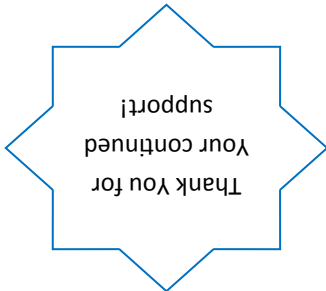
